

Effective upon the triggering of a “Bad Moon Rising Bad Beat Jackpot” after July 4, 2025, the following rules shall apply:

1. “Omaha InstaPays” will be available during all operating hours where a High Hand Promotion is not in Play.
2. For jackpot eligible four-card Omaha games “Omaha InstaPays” will pay \$599 for a flopped Royal Flush, and \$200 for a flopped Straight Flush.
3. Players are only eligible for the higher of the two payouts if flopping both a Royal Flush and Straight Flush.
4. To be eligible a minimum of four players must be dealt in, there must be \$10 (including rake and jackpot) in the pot, and a \$2 jackpot drop must be collected.
5. In a “bomb pot” where two separate jackpot drops have been taken, players may win “Omaha InstaPays” on Either Board. When running a hand twice only the main board will be eligible for “Omaha InstaPays.”
6. Time Raked games, Texas Hold’em, five-card Omaha variants, and Mixed games are not eligible.
7. Players may not fold and must show all four cards to be eligible for “Omaha InstaPays.”
8. Players must play their hand independently. If any player, whether directly or indirectly involved in the hand, passes information or instructs another on how to act or reveals their hand to the other players, “Omaha InstaPays” will be disqualified.
9. Any dispute or situation not covered by the official rules will be resolved by Poker Management in a manner deemed by them to be the fairest to all concerned, and that decision shall be final and binding on all participants. In addition, management may void any entry, and/or change, cancel, or modify this promotion at any time.
10. Management reserves the right to verify the eligibility of all qualifying hands.
11. All recipients of jackpot money shall be required to provide valid photo ID, valid TIN, and shall be issued an IRS Form W9 reflecting the amount won in the jackpot. Winners will be solely responsible for all taxes.
12. If a winner cannot provide a valid S.S. number (on W9) for all Jackpots 24% will be withheld as required by Federal Information Return. If a winner has not claimed and /or cannot provide property ID within six (6) months of winning the high hand their money will be forfeited back to the player’s fund.
