TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Players will start this event with 10,000 tournament chips.
2. Levels will last 15 minutes each.
3. \$70 Buy-in = \$50 prize pool + \$13 administrative fee + \$7 staff gratuity. Option 2: \$50 prize pool + \$20
4. On-Site Registration and unlimited re-entries are available until the start of level 9. No refunds.
5. Pre-purchased stacks and satellite winners will be Live on the table from the beginning of the tournament. Alternate and late sign ups will start with a fresh stack.
6. Tournament uses Big Blind Ante. The Blind is paid before the Ante.
7. Tournament tickets are non-refundable and nontransferable.
8. This tournament is scheduled for one day. The Tournament Director in their sole and absolute discretion may adjust the break schedule, the start and stop time, and the level lengths.
9. A minimum of 4 players must register within 30 minutes of the scheduled start time for the tournament to proceed.
10. Approximately one (1) in every six (6) players will win a seat in the September Showdown Series Event 1 \$300 Kickoff held September 9th at 12:10pm
11. A redraw will occur at 9 players or at Tournament Director's discretion.
12. In the spirit of TDA Rule #1, it is each player's responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
