3. \$200 Buy-in = \$165 prize pool+ \$25 administrative fee + \$10 staff fees. Option 2: \$200 Buy-in = \$165 prize pool + \$35 administrative fee.
4. On-Site Registration and unlimited re-entries are available until the start of level 10. No refunds.
5. Pre-purchased stacks and satellite winners will be Live on the table from the beginning of the tournament. Alternate and late sign ups will start with a fresh stack.
6. Tournament uses Big Blind Ante. The Blind is paid before the Ante.
7. This tournament is scheduled for one day. The tournament director in their sole and absolute discretion may adjust the break schedule, the start and stop time, the level lengths, and/or add additional day(s) if necessary.
8. Winner of this event will receive a \$500 seat (from the prize pool) into \$500 Fall Cash-Out held on September 26th at 11:10am.
9. A redraw will occur at 9 players or at Tournament Director's discretion.
